4v4 Player Development Festival

4v4 Soccer Tournament designed for individual play and development. You do not even have to be a top level premier or travel player to enjoy this event. A full team is not needed, you can sign up as an individual, teammates, friends, or as a full team, but you will play to WIN it all by yourself!

Date/Time: March 28, from 4 to 8 pm

Format: 4v4 scramble play, 5 - 12 to 15 minute games guaranteed, all participants play at the same time.

Cost: \$25

Location: The Heart of Lancaster Quad at Hempfield High School in Landisville

Ages: Division for U9/U10 Boys and Girls and a division for U11/12 Boys and Girls

Tournament Characteristics:

- One overall winner, awards for the top 10 players of a 60 person or more event, top 5 for a 40 person event.
- Games all run the same length and time, and all games are played at the same time, no half time, no timeouts.
- Each individual will have different teammates in each game (some games may have an individual that you have played with before)
- Small goals are used with NO goalkeepers.
- Players must find out for themselves what fields they are on from game to game. Individuals will be given their game schedule at the beginning of the event.
- Players have to figure out their positions amongst themselves, NO goalkeepers or players guarding the goal.
- Players keep track of the score themselves.
- There are NO referees, NO coaches, NO Parents on the team sidelines. There WILL be a tournament person at each field to encourage them and watch over them.
- Players control the rules themselves, any discrepancy that cannot be resolved within 10 seconds goes to rock, paper, scissors to solve.
- Each player receives 10 pts for a WIN, 5 pts for a TIE, and regardless of a Win or a LOSS, 1 point is award for each goal scored by his/her team. Ex. #1 - Team A wins 2-1 over Team B, everyone on Team A receives 10 pts for the win and 2 pts for 2 goals scored (total of 12 pts.). Everyone on Team B get 0 pts for the loss, but 1 pt for a goal. Ex. #2 – Team C ties Team D 5-5, everyone on both teams would receive 10 pts. (5 for the tie and 5 for their goals scored)

Tournament Rules/Fields:

- Small Fields roughly 30x40 yards (size will vary depending on age groups and numbers)
- Small 3v3 goals, PUG goals, hurdles, or corner flags can be used for goals. Best situation is 3v3 goals are used.
- Fields are marked with letters for each half. On 1 field, one side will be A and the other B. All players with the letter A associated to their name go the goal to meet.
- Each field will have pinnies at one of the goals or lettered side of the field. If play shows up at a location with them, they are to wear them for that game. Once game is over, pinnies are dropped back at the goal mouth for the next game.
- Game ball should be the appropriate size for the age group. Players will determine what ball they want to use to play with.
- Games are 12 to 15 minutes long
- All balls played out of bounds on the sidelines will be restarted with a pass in. NO throw INS.
- There are NO corner kicks, if a defending team causes 3 corner kicks, the opposing team will get a penalty kick from their own goal mouth (free shot from length of the field)
- Goal kicks are a pass in from the side the ball went out on from the end line.
- All free kick awarded (with exception to penalty kick) are INDIRECT kicks. Players must be 5 feet from the ball on any kick.
- Games and after every goal all start with a joust . 1 Player from each team puts their right foot on the ball and on the count of three, they pull the ball back with their foot and try to will it for their team.
- NO offside's
- Subs, if any, are made on the fly. All players MUST play unless injured.
- Once at each field, team needs to designate a team captain. This person will be the one doing Rock, Paper, Scissors if needed.
- Reporting the score must be down to the designated field marshal by the two captains of the teams playing.

Tournament Concept:

- To provoke Individual thought and responsibilities
- Give back the concept of playing in the back yard or in the streets that so many of us did as kids.
- Having no real authority to tell us what to do and when to do it. Problems are solved BY THE PLAYERS through discussion and quick resolution of on old childhood game (rock, paper, scissors).
- Working in small groups to obtain one goal
- Getting and maximizing the number of touches on the ball by playing with less players on the field
- Playing a scramble format so one team never dominates
- Playing a scramble format so it forces players to learn from one another, learn and meet from new teammates.
- Develop new friendships and meet new players from other teams
- Gives everyone involved the opportunity to WIN, regardless of your level of play.
- Have FUN.

Tournament COST: Each individual signing up for the tournament will pay \$25 for their registration. An application and Waiver will be available for all to fill out and turn in with payment. All payments are to be made to CPYSL (Central Penn Youth Soccer League)
